- ✓ Itálica is an ancient roman town located in Santiponce/Sevilla. It was the first roman town founded in Hispania (206 BC).
- ✓ It got its greatest splendor at the end of the I century and during the II century since Trajano and Adriano's reigns.

The most important archaeological remains:

- **The amphitheater:** It had a capacity for 25.000 spectators. It was one of the biggest of the Roman Empire.
- **The Roman theater:** It's the most ancient building of Itálica. Now the Italic Theater Festival is celebrated there.
- **The Thermas:** They had many pools they had hot, warm and cold water.
- The aqueducts, the wall, houses of rich families, etc....
